

# Butterfly Night

## Dinner Shopping List:

Butterfly pork chops  
Bell peppers and corn (or veggie of choice)  
Crescent rolls  
grapes

## Activity:

Butterfly net

## Craft:

Colored paper  
Clothes pin  
Pipe cleaner  
Colors  
Glue

## Dinner & Dessert: Metamorphosis

Slice pepper to look like a flower. Fill with veggie of choice. Cook crescent rolls according to package. Use toothpicks to stick grapes together in the shape of a caterpillar. Snip butterfly pork chop in the center of each side to make a top wing and a bottom wing. Snip the middle up a little on the bottom and then snip the top to separate the meat into the antennae sections. You should be able to see where there are 2 distinct meat sections at the top. Arrange on plate in order of metamorphosis of a butterfly. Flower for the grape caterpillar, then the crescent roll cocoon then the butterfly.

## Craft: Butterfly Hands

Use colored paper and trace the outline of each hand onto the paper. Fingers spread for the top wings, fingers together for the bottom wings. Cut out wings, color and then glue onto a clothes pin. Twist a length of pipe cleaner for the antennae and click into the clothes pin.

## Activity: Butterfly games

Use a butterfly net and head outside to catch a butterfly...or any other bugs. If no butterflies can be found, play inside with the nets. Pieces of tissue paper can be blown with a fan as the kids try to catch them in the net. If you have the elephant game that blows the butterflies out of the nose, then play that game.
